Your submission should include:

- Your name, organizational affiliation, and contact information
- Title of the presentation
- Preferred format (skill-building workshop, roundtable discussion, oral, poster)
- Population(s) addressed
- 250-word abstract
- Three (3) learning objectives. For example: By the end of this presentation, participants will be able to
  - 1. List various core competencies for community members' equitable involvement in research.
  - 2. Describe effective training methods in research for immigrant community members.

- Submitting authors will receive notification of acceptance by 5:00PM on Friday, October 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2020.
- Abstracts for oral presentations will be grouped together by conference organizers to create thematic sessions.
